Minimum Qualifications:

- 18 years of age
- High School Diploma (or equivalent) or higher
- Must possess a valid CA driver's license at time of application
- Must possess a valid CA EMT or EMT-Paramedic card at time of application
- Must possess a valid CPAT card successfully completed in 2019/20 at time of application (see "How to Apply" for further information)

Desirable Qualifications:

- CA Firefighter I or Academy graduate
- Current firefighting and EMS experience
- College Fire Science studies
- NWCG Firefighter Type 2

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to learn firefighting tactics and Marin County EMS protocols
- Ability to learn, operate and maintain District equipment
- Ability to act calmly and effectively in emergency situations
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions
- Ability to communicate effectively
- Ability to maintain harmonious relationships with others in a group-living environment
- Ability to do strenuous physical activity for extended periods of time

The District:

The Tiburon Fire Protection District was formed in 1941 and is a combination department with 22 career under the direction of Chief Richard Pearce. The District has three shifts with a Battalion Chief, Captain, Lieutenant, 4 Firefighters and Firefighter/Paramedics, and 2 Firefighter-Trainees per shift working a 48/96 schedule.

The District provides emergency response, fire prevention and public education to a 6 square mile area. Annually, the District responds to approximately 1700 emergency incidents utilizing a modern fleet of emergency response apparatus including 3 Type I engines, 2 Type III engines, a medium rescue, a Moose fireboat and 1 ambulance. The District belongs to the Southern Marin Emergency Paramedic System, a JPA that provides ALS treatment and transportation to the residents of the Southern Marin area.

The Community:

The Tiburon Fire Protection District is located in southern Marin County. We are bordered by the Richardson Bay, San Francisco Bay, and Angel Island State Park. We serve the communities of Tiburon, Belvedere, and parts of unincorporated Marin County. Our citizens enjoy spectacular views of the Mount Tamalpais and Angel Island State Parks, the Golden Gate National Recreation Area, and the Richmond-San Rafael, Golden Gate, and Bay Bridges.

Letter of intent optional. **You must include documentation of the minimum qualifications as listed under "Qualifications" on this flier.** List "Desired", and any additional, qualifications under "Training" on Pg. 4 of the application but do NOT include copies of certifications, classes or licenses. **Your application may not be considered if submitted incomplete and/or you are unable to properly follow the instructions put forth on this flier.**

Applications will be accepted at District headquarters: 1679 Tiburon Boulevard, Tiburon, CA 94920, beginning 9:00am November 16, 2020. For applications sent by USPS/FedEx/UPS to be considered, the application must be received prior to the application filing deadline on December 18, 2020 at 12:00pm.

Valid CPAT cards will have a successful completion date in 2020/21. If your CPAT card is dated prior to January 1, 2020 you MUST submit proof of registration for renewal, and successfully renew, prior to date of hire. No exceptions.
